Looking Forward to Future Travel

I hope this finds everyone safe and healthy! We have all been affected by the coronavirus pandemic that has taken hold of the country, and the world.

COVID-19 has limited where and when we can travel, and the number of people who can gather in one place. For this reason, we have canceled several Advantage Club

trips this year and will be canceling our May 20th Lunch and Learn. The next scheduled trip is A Day Fit for a Queen, on June 10th. A decision on this trip will be made closer to the date of the trip, as we monitor the recommendations and restrictions provided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and the State of Missouri.

The question everyone is asking is when will the coronavirus end and when can we resume normal life? Although there's no projected date, we know we will return to our traditional lives soon. So, what better time to start looking forward to future travel!

The extended trips for 2021 are included in this newsletter. Our first extended trip next year takes you to sunny Florida for Cardinals Spring Training in Jupiter. During our stay we'll head to Roger Dean Stadium to see two exciting Cardinals games, visit the picturesque Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse and explore the fascinating Loggerhead Marinelife Center. We'll take a guided tour of Palm Beach, the richest town in the U.S., followed by a visit to Everglades Holiday Park for an airboat journey deep into the Everglades.

In June you can witness the awe-inspiring scenery of Niagara Falls, the beautiful attractions in Toronto, and the quaintness of Niagara-on-the-Lake on our five-day, four-night Niagara Falls and Toronto tour. You will get up close and personal to one of the world's most stunning natural wonders as we tour Niagara Falls on the Canadian side. Sites include Horseshoe Falls, the Great Whirlpools, Niagara Parks Floral Clock, Upper Canadian Rapids, and Queen Victoria Park. You will enjoy a thrilling boat trip to experience the force of this phenomenon on the Hornblower Cruise and explore sites in Toronto.

If you prefer a motor coach trip, join us and experience Colorful Colorado. On this seven day, six night trip, we'll explore a number of natural wonders, ride the cog railway to the top of Pike's Peak, experience American's most spectacular rail journey aboard the Royal Gorge Route Railroad, tour the United States Air Force Academy and visit the U.S. Olympic & Paralympic Museum. We'll have fun in Dodge City and Hutchison, Kansas on our way to and from Colorado.

In early October we have a fabulous trip to the Canyonlands of Southern Utah. We fly to Salt Lake City, and over the next six days this tour takes us to a Mormon Tabernacle Choir radio broadcast, Dead Horse Point State Park with its dramatic pinnacles, buttes, gorges and cliffs, and Canyonlands National Park. We'll take a half-day float trip along the Colorado River and experience "Canyonlands by Night" as a jet boat takes us on a cruise through the illuminated cliffs along the Colorado River. We'll visit amazing Arches National

Park and Zion National Park, just to name a few of the parks. Our tour culminates in Las Vegas where we'll have a free evening to explore before we board our flight home the following day.







Canyonlands of Southern Utah

Mark your calendars now so you won't miss this fabulous trip to the amazing Canyonlands of Southern Utah. Our trip starts with a flight to Salt Lake City where we'll check into the beautiful Little America Hotel for one night. Enjoy dinner at the Roof Restaurant overlooking Temple Square.

Over the next six days this exciting tour will take us to a Mormon Tabernacle Choir radio broadcast, Dead Horse Point State Park with its dramatic pinnacles, buttes, gorges and cliffs, and Canyonlands National Park, where at Upheaval Dome we'll marvel at the park's magnificent spires and mesas that rise up to 7,100 feet! We'll take a half-day float trip along the Colorado River amidst red sandstone monuments and mesas and through deep canyons that showcase 320 million years of geologic history. And we'll experience "Canyonlands by Night" as a jet boat takes us on a cruise through the illuminated cliffs along the Colorado River. We'll visit amazing Arches National Park, an extraordinary product of erosion in the form of giant arches, windows and pedestals that change color constantly in the sunlight.

We'll spend two days traveling along what Reader's Digest has designated as one of "The Most Scenic Drives in America." From Moab we'll head south, skirting the Manti-La Sal National Forest and continuing along the Bicentennial Highway to Natural Bridges National Monument with its three natural bridges carved out of sandstone rising 220 feet above the streambed with a span of 268 feet. Crossing Lake Powell at Cataract Canyon in the Glen Canyon National Recreation Area, our scenic drive brings us to Capitol Reef National Park know for narrow high-walled gorges, colorful sedimentary formations and white sandstone domes. Then it's onward along Utah's Highway 12 Scenic Byway, which winds through alpine mountains and colorful rock formations. We'll see the newly created Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument and the Escalante Petrified Forest before our arrival at Bryce Canyon National Park. The long series of amphitheaters filled with eroded limestone towers called hoodoos make this one of the most photogenic places in America.

Zion National Park caps off this tour filled with an abundance of awe-inspiring natural beauty. A narrated tram ride will take us past sheer rust-colored sandstone cliffs that rise thousands of feet in every direction. Hanging gardens cling to the porous rock and a forest of Cottonwood trees accompany the Virgin River on its carving path through the depths of the canyon. Every turn in the road is a photo stop. Our tour culminates in Las Vegas where we'll have a free evening to explore before we board our flight home the following day, taking with us fond memories of the beautiful sites and fun activities we have experienced in *spectacular canyon country!*



Due to the circumstances resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic and the national emergency declaration, the Department of Homeland Security is extending the REAL ID enforcement deadline by a year. Beginning October 1, 2021, every air traveler 18 years of age and older will need a REAL ID-compliant driver's license, state-issued enhanced driver's license, or another acceptable form of ID to fly within the United States. US passports are Real ID-approved. This means that if you were to fly domestically and do not have a new ID, you can use your passport as a type of identification.
