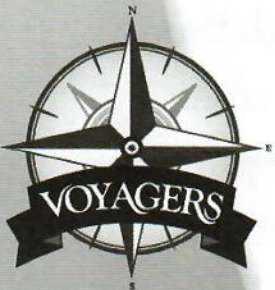
We look forward to continuing to serve you and your families in the months and years to come.

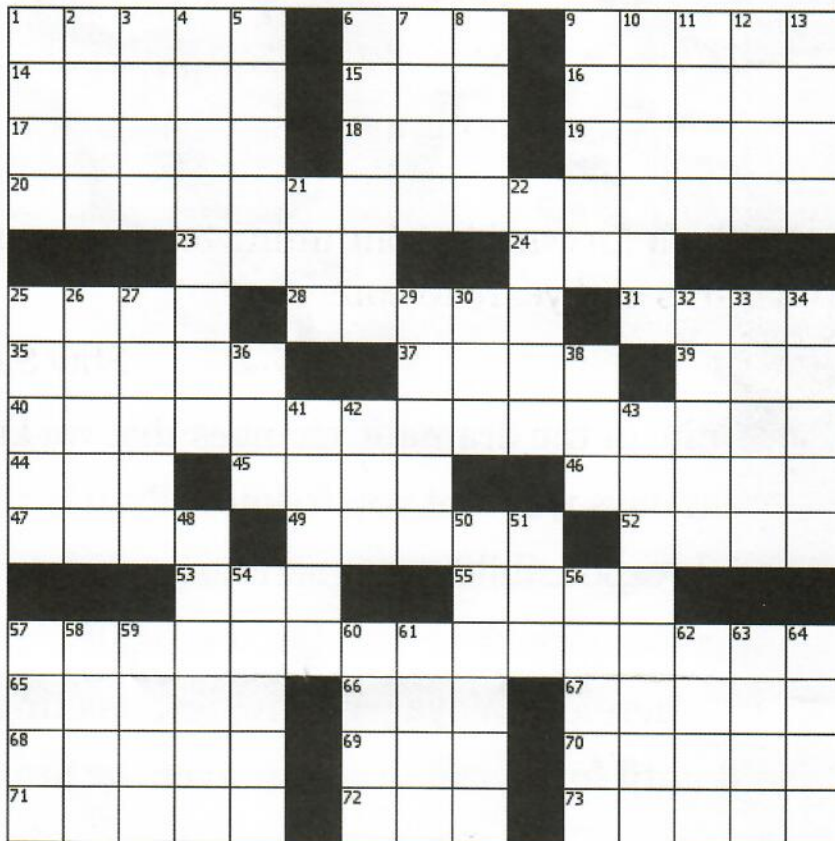
